## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 20 MINING STOCKS 1926=100

The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 115.0 for the week ending October 12th, as compared with 116.7 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks fell from 111.9 to 111.0, four gold-copper stocks from 148.7 to 143.9, and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 42.2 to 41.6.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:- Kirkland Lake declined from  $38\phi$  to  $36\phi$ . McIntyre from \$45.84 to \$43.36, Teck-Hughes from \$6.65 to \$6.49 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$8.21 to \$8.15. Coniarum mounted from  $79\phi$  to  $86\phi$ , Hollinger from \$10.62 to \$10.65, Lake Shore from \$49.54 to \$49.71 and Sylvanite from \$1.22 to \$1.27.

Average weekly prices were lower for all of the gold-copper stocks.

Amulet dropped from 48¢ to 46¢, Hudson Bay from \$10.52 to \$9.92, Noranda from \$36.20 to \$35.56 and Sherritt-Gordon from \$1.26 to \$1.15.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Keeley fell from 53¢ to 48¢ and Mining Corporation from \$2.02 to \$1.98 while Nipissing rose from \$2.61 to \$2.64.
