## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 20 MINING STOCKS (1926 = 100)

The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926-100, was 112.7 for the week ending November 16th, as compared with 111.5 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 107.9 to 109.0, four-gold-copper stocks from 137.7 to 139.4, and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 42.3 to 42.4.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:- Conjarum mounted from 88¢ to 90¢, Dome from \$36.13 to \$37.30, Hollinger from \$10.40 to \$10.73, McIntyre from \$43.05 to \$44.04 and Vipond Consolidated from 48¢ to 50¢. Kirkland Lake declined from 36¢ to 34¢, Take Shore from \$49.11 to \$49.06 and Teck-Hughes from \$6.08 to \$6.05.

Average weekly prices were higher for two of the gold-copper stocks. Hudson Bay rose from \$9.54 to \$9.96 and Noranda from \$34.16 to \$34.27.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Castle-Trethewey mounted from 57¢ to 62¢, Keeley from 48¢ to 50¢ and Nipissing from \$2.63 to \$2.71 while Mining Corporation dropped from \$1.94 to \$1.91.
