The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926-100, was 105.0 for the week ending November 30th, as compared with 108.3 for the previous week

Eleven gold stocks fell from 103.5 to 100.5, four gold-copper stocks from 138.1 to 133.9, and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 39.8 to 38.0.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:- Lake Shore declined from \$47.23 to \$45.82. McIntyre \$39.97 to \$35.89. Premier from \$1.10 to \$1.03, Sylvanite from \$1.22 to \$1.17. Teck-Hughes from \$5.71 to \$5.58. Vipond Consolidated from 50\$ to 45\$ and Wright-Hargreeves from \$7.2 to \$6.84.

Average weekly prices were lower for three of the gold-copper stocks. Hudson Bay dropped from \$9.72 to \$9.26. Norande from \$34.26 to \$33.54 and Sherritt-Gordon from \$1.03 to 95%.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Castle-Trethewey fell from 57¢ to 53¢, Mining Corporation from \$1.79 to \$1.7 and Mining from \$2.52 to \$2.42.
