## WEIGHTED ITDEX NUNBERS OF 20 MINING STOCKS

 $1926=100$The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base $1926=100$ was 67.3 for the week ending March 9th, as compared with 70.5 for the previous week

Eleven gold stocks fell from 69.6 to 66.2 , four gold-copper stocks from 80.9 to 77.8 , and five silver and miscellaneous stocks rose from 26.2 to 26.3 .

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices bohaved as follows:- Dome declined from $\$ 15.21$ to $\$ 14.51$, Hollinger from $\$ 7.13$ to $\$ 6.76$, Lake Shore from $\$ 34.89$ to $\$ 33.15$, McInture from $\$ 24.08$ to $\$ 22.78$, Sylvanite from $88 \%$ to $84 \phi$, Teck-Hughes from $\$ 4.17$ to $\$ 4.00$ and $\pi \cdot 1$ ght-Hargreaves from $\$ 4.33$ to $\$ 4.11$. coniarum mounted from 29 . to $34 \%$.

Average weekly prices were lower for two, unchanged for one and higher for one of the gold-copper stocks. Hudson Bay dropped from $\$ 3.48$ to $\$ 3.44$ and Noranda from $\$ 23.02$ to $\$ 21.97$ while Amulet rose from $15 \phi$ to $16 \phi$.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Castle-Irethewey mounted from $22 \phi$ to $24 \phi$ and Nipissing from $\$ 1.53$ to $\$ 1.59$. Keely fell from $23 \phi$ to $22 \phi$ and Mining Corporation from $\$ 1.41$ to $\$ 1.37$.
