WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF SC MINING STOCKS

1926=100

The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926 = 100, was 69.5 for the week ending March 16th, as compared with 67.3 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 66.2 to 67.4, four gold-copper stocks from 77.8 to 83.9, and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 26.3 to 26.8.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows: Dome mounted from \$14.51 to \$15.19, Hollinger from \$6.76 to \$7.02, McIntyre from \$22.78 to \$23.31, Sylvanite from \$4¢ to 87¢, Teck-Hughes from \$4.00 to \$4.10, Vipend Consolidated from 32¢ to 37¢ and Wright-Hargreaves from \$4.11 to \$4.19. Contarum fell from 34¢ to 29¢.

Average weekly prices were higher for all of the gold-copper stocks. Amulet rose from 16ϕ to 18ϕ , Hudson Bay from \$3.44 to \$3.94, Noranda from \$21.97 to \$23.32 and Sherritt-Gordon from 40¢ to 46¢.

In the silver and iscellaneous group, Mining Corporation mounted from \$1.37 to \$1.43 and Nipissing from \$1.59 to \$1.62.
