

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## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 20 MINING STOCKS

1926 = 100

The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 69.0 for the week ending April 6th, as compared with 68.2 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 66.5 to 68.4, four gold-copper stocks fell from 81.1 to 78.9, and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 26.5 to 25.8.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:— Dome mounted from \$15.74 to \$15.85, Hollinger from \$7.02 to \$7.47, Lake Shore from \$32.05 to \$32.79, McIntyre from \$23.10 to \$23.93, Teck-Hughes from \$4.09 to \$4.17 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$4.25 to \$4.36. Premier fell from  $69\phi$  to  $65\phi$ .

Average weekly prices were lower for two and higher for two of the gold-copper stocks. Hudson Bay declined from \$3.82 to \$3.77 and Noranda from \$22.64 to \$21.90 while Amulet rose from  $15\phi$  to  $16\phi$  and Sherritt-Gordon from  $42\phi$  to  $43\phi$ .

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Castle-Trethewey dropped from  $21\phi$  to  $19\phi$ , Mining Corporation from \$1.39 to \$1.34 and Nipissing from \$1.53 to \$1.48. Keely mounted from  $31\phi$  to  $33\phi$ .
