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## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 20 MINING STOCKS 1920=100

The weighted index number of twenty mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 85.6 for the week ending May 11th, as compared with 82.1 for the previous week.

Eleven gold stocks rose from 77.9 to 82.1, four gold-copper stocks from 105.4 to 111.1, and five silver and miscellaneous stocks from 31.8 to 35.0.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:Coniarum mounted from 39¢ to 42¢, Dome from \$19.62 to \$22.77, Hollinger from \$8.87 to \$9.22, Kirkland Lake from 35¢ to 37¢, Lake Shore from \$36.74 to \$38.24, McIntyre from \$28.59 to \$28.76, Premier from 69¢ to 71¢, Sylvanite from 89¢ to 91¢, Teck-Hughes from \$4.41 to \$4.81, Vipond Consolidated from 39¢ to 42¢ and Wright-Hargreaves from \$4.91 to \$5.19.

Average weekly prices were higher for all of the gold-copper stocks. Amulet rose from 19¢ to 22¢, Hudson Bay from \$6.44 to \$7.33, Noranda from \$27.50 to \$28.03 and Sherritt-Gordon from 58¢ to 72¢.

In the silver and miscellaneous group, Castle-Trethewey mounted from  $38\phi$  to  $44\phi$ . Keeley from  $38\phi$  to  $39\phi$ , Mining Corporation from \$1.58 to \$1.63 and Nipissing from \$1.90 to \$2.11.
