## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS 1926=100

The weighted index number of twenty-three mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 122.4 for the week ending November 22nd, as compared with 129.5 for the previous week.

Nineteen gold stocks fell from 129.7 to 122.8, and four base metals stocks from 133.2 to 125.0.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:- Bralorne declined from \$13.13 to \$12.55, Dome from \$37.74 to \$36.09, Granada from 29¢ to 25¢, Hollinger from \$20.19 to \$18.79, Howey from \$1.12 to \$1.05, Kirkland Lake from 61¢ to 54¢, Lake Shore from \$54.71 to \$52.26, Macassa from \$2.67 to \$2.43, McIntyre from \$41.25 to \$40.36, Premier from \$1.28 to \$1.23, Pioneer from \$11.92 to \$11.58, Reno from \$1.10 to \$1.05, San Antonio from \$4.34 to \$3.94, Siscoe from \$2.64 to \$2.52, Sylvanite from \$2.49 to \$2.26, Teck-Hughes from \$4.03 to \$3.93 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$8.68 to \$8.07.

In the base metals group, Base Metals dropped from 77¢ to 71¢, Falconbridge from \$3.47 to \$3.20, Hudson Bay from \$12.16 to \$11.49 and Noranda from \$33.50 to \$31.43.
