Greenway, M.A. WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS (1926-100) The weighted index number of twenty-three mining stocks computed by the Dominion Burcau of Statistics on the base 1925-100. Was 112.9 for the week ending February 8th, as compared with 108.6 for the previous week. Nineteen gold stocks rose from 104.1 to 108.4, and four base metals stocks from 128.9 to 133.5. Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:-Dome mounted from \$33.45 to \$34.94, Graneda from 62\$\psi\$ to 66\$\psi\$, Hollinger from \$12.19 to \$13.20, Howey 97\$\psi\$ to \$1.00, Lake Shore from \$43.35 to \$44.32, McIntyre from \$40.30 to \$41.47, Pioneer from \$11.55 to \$12.28, Reno from \$1.05 to \$1.17, San Antonio from \$1.80 to \$2.14, Siscoe from \$1.54 to \$1.65, Sylvanite from \$1.65 to \$1.94, Teck-Hughes from \$5.87 to \$5.94 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$6.94 to \$7.25. In the base metal group, Hudson Bay advanced from \$9.34 to \$9.93 and Noranda from \$34.23 to \$35.38 while Base Metals remained unchanged at \$1.77 and Falconbridge at \$3.16.
