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## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 UINING STOCKS $(1926=100)$

The weighted index number of twenty-three mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base $1926=100$, was 124.6 for the woak ending March 8th, as compared with 115.4 for tho previous mock.

Ninetoen gold stocks rose from 111.6 to 12015 , and four base metals stocks from 133.5 to 144.2 .
