## WEIGEMED INDEX, NUWETS OF 23 MINING STOCKS <br> (1926:100)

The weighted index number of twenty-threc mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on tho baso $1926=100$, was 128.6 for tho weck onding March 15 th, as compared \#ith 124.6 for the provious wook.

Nineteen gold stocks rose from 120.5 to 123.8 , and four base metals stocks from 144.2 to 151.4 .

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:- Bralome mounted from $\$ 11.31$ to $\$ 12.76$, Coniarm from $\$ 1.44$ to $\$ 1.50$, Dome from $\$ 36.85$ to $\$ 37.46$, Granada from 75 to 78 , Hollinger from $\$ 25.89$ to $\$ 16.14$, Kirkland Lake from $36 \phi$ to $56 \phi$, Lake Shore from $\$ 4$. 88 to $\$ 48,02$, Macassa from $\$ 2.32$ to $\$ 2.40$, McIntyre from $\$ 42.65$ to $\$ 44.20$, Premier from $\$ 1.62$ to $\$ 1.66$, Pioncor from $\$ 12.08$ to $\$ 12.15$, San Antonio from $\$ 2.78$ to $\$ 2.96$, Tock-Hughos from $\$ 6.53$ to $\$ 6.77$ and Wright-Hareroaves from $\$ 8.37$ to $\$ 8.86$. Homey foll from $\$ 1.28$ to $\$ 1.26$ and Reno from $\$ 1.22$ to $\$ 1.14$.

In the baso metal group, Base Motals adrancod from $\$ 1.79$ to $\$ 1.93$, Falconbridge from $\$ 3.51$ to $\$ 3.96$, Hudson Bay from $\$ 11.38$ to $\$ 12.21$ and Noranda from $\$ 37.48$ to $\$ 38.60$.
