WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS (1926=100)

The weighted index number of twenty-three mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 138.3 for the week ending April 19th, as compared with 141.1 for the previous week.

Nineteen gold stocks fell from 135.7 to 132.5, and four base metals stocks from 167.0 to 165.6.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:- Bralorno declined from \$14.42 to \$14.06, Coniarum from \$1.37 to \$1.32, Dome from \$38.53 to \$37.44, Granada from 95¢ to 84¢, Hollinger from \$17.84 to \$17.45, Kirkland Lake from 63¢ to 61¢, Lake Shore from \$53.29 to \$52.08, Macassa from \$2.74 to \$2.60, McIntyre from \$48.44 to \$47.71, Pioneer from \$13.94 to \$13.39, Reno from \$1.06 to 97¢, San Antonio from \$3.93 to \$3.75, Sylvanite from \$2.94 to \$2.80, Teck-Hughes from \$7.37 \$7.13 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$9.73 to \$9.66.

In the base metal group, Base Metals dropped from \$1.76 to \$1.71, Hudson Bay from \$13.83 to \$13.73 and Noranda from \$43.37 to \$42.93 while Falconbridge rose from \$3.81 to \$3.83
