## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS (1926=100)

The weighted index number of twenty-three mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926-100, was 141.9 for the week ending April 5th as compared with 131.3 for the previous week. At this level, the index was higher than it had been in any year subsequent to 1927.

Nineteen gold stocks rose from 128.3 to 139.0, and four base motals stocks from 147.4 to 158.2.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:— Bralorne mounted from \$13.08 to \$14.89, Coniarum from \$1.27 to \$1.42, Dome from \$39.02 to \$39.79. Granada from 77¢ to 95¢, Hollinger from \$17.00 to \$18.88, Howey from \$1.16 to \$1.28, Lake Shore from \$49.90 to \$53.34, Macassa from \$2.38 to \$2.70, McIntyre from \$46.52 to \$49.47, Premier from \$1.45 to \$1.47, Pioneer from \$12.22 to \$13.29, Reno from \$1.10 to \$1.16, San Antonio from \$3.33 to \$3.56, Siscoe from \$2.19 to \$2.48, Sylvanite from \$2.77 to \$3.10, Teck-Hughes from \$6.86 to \$7.78 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$9.35 to \$9.96.

from In the base metal group, Base Metals advanced from \$1.72 to \$1.75. Falcon bridge \$3.77 to \$3.89, Hudson Bay from \$11.31 to \$12.39 and Noranda from \$38.54 to \$41.41.
