Greenway, M.A. WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS 1926=100 The weighted index number of twenty-three mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 134.3 for the week ending July 26th, as compared with 140.1 for the previous week. Nineteen gold stocks fell from 136.0 to 130.7, and four base metals stocks from 161.9 to 154.1. Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows:— Bralorne declined from \$16.34 to \$15.83, Coniarum from \$1.33 to \$1.26, Dome from \$43.00 to \$40.10, Granada from 66¢ to 59¢, Hollinger from \$17.64 to \$17.14, Howey from \$1.27 to \$1.23, Lake Shore from \$54.07 to \$52.07, McIntyre from \$48.30 to \$45.33, Premier from \$1.26 to \$1.23, Pioneer from \$13.26 to \$12.30, Reno from 99¢ to 93¢, San Antonio from \$5.87 to \$5.37, Sylvanite from \$2.82 to \$2.65, Teck-Hughes from \$6.84 to \$6.55 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$9.52 to \$9.33 from \$9.52 to \$9.33. In the base metals group, Base Metals dropped from \$1.19 to \$1.07, Falconbridge from \$3.49 to \$3.44, Hudson Bay from \$13.14 to \$12.89 and Noranda from \$43.25 to \$40.62.
