The weighted index number of twenty-three mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, was 135.0 for the week ending August 9th, as compared with 132.2 for the previous week.

Nineteen gold stocks rose from 129.2 to134.7, and four base metals stocks from 149.6 to 156.8.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows: - Bralorne mounted from \$15.78 to \$15.84, Dome from \$39.44 to \$41.97, Granada from 63¢ to 65¢, Hollinger from \$17.73 to \$18.36, Howey from \$1.18 to \$1.24, Kirkland Lake from 53¢ to 55¢, Lake Shere from \$50.62 to \$52.63, Macassa from \$2.47 to \$2.60, McIntyre from \$43.54 to \$47.12, Premier from \$1.20 to \$1.29, Pioneer from \$12.14 to \$13.00, Reno from \$9¢ to 94¢, San Antonio from \$5.37 to \$5.51, Siscoe from \$2.40 to \$2.45, Sylvanite from \$2.56 to \$2.66, Teck-Hughes from \$6.55 to \$6.63 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$8.98 to \$9.34.

In the base metals group, Base Metals advanced from 96¢ to \$1.01. Falconbridge from \$3.43 to \$3.53, Hudson Bay from \$12.66 to \$13.20 and Noranda from \$39.21 to \$41.26.
