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## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS (1926=100)

Higher prices in both gold and base metals groups were responsible for a modest advance of the general mining stocks index as indicated by 118.1 for the week of October 17, as compared with 116.3 for the week of October 10. During the same interval in 1934, this index was 137.9.

Hollinger leading with an appreciable gain, most of the gold issues registered increases, placing the index at 104.7 for the week of October 17. For the week of October 10 the index was 102.6 and for the week of October 18, last year the index recorded was 137.0.

Regardless of a decline in prices of Base Metals and Hudson Bay, four base metals index mounted from 171.8 for the week of October 10 to 172.6 for the week of October 17. The index for the corresponding period in 1934 was 146.8.

A comparative table of prices, as compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the weeks of October 17th, 10th, 1935, and October 18th, 1934, is listed below.
