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## WETGHTE INDEX NURER CT 23 ITNING STOCKS <br> ( $1926=100$ )

The weighted index number of twenty-three mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the basc $1926=100$, was 120.5 for the week ending Pebruary 7 th, as compared with 120.3 for the previous week.

Nineteen gold stocks rose from 119.0 to 119.4 , and four base metals stocks fell from 129.0 to 128.6.

Among the gold stocks weekly average prices behaved as follows: Bralorne mounted from $\$ 9.90$ to $\$ 9.99$, Dome from $\$ 35.81$ to $\$ 36.54$, Macassa from $\$ 2.32$ to $\$ 2.39$, MoIntyre from $\$ 37.61$ to $\$ 39.00$, Pioneer from $\$ 9.90$ to $\$ 10.02$ and Reno from $\$ 1.29$ to \$1.34. Coniarum declined from $\$ 2.13$ to $\$ 2.03$, Hollinger from $\$ 18.00$ to $\$ 17.94$, Lake Shore from $\$ 50.35$ to $\$ 50.21$, Premier from $\$ 1.50$ to $\$ 1.48$, San Antonio from $\$ 4.23$ to \$4.11, Siscoe from ${ }^{2} 2.57$ to $\$ 2.54$ and Teck-Hughes from $\$ 3.77$ to $\$ 3.74$.

In the base metals group, Hudson Bay dropped from $\$ 12.14$ to $\$ 12.09$, Noranda from $\$ 32.42$ to $\$ 32.14$ and Base iietals from 59 to $58 \%$ while Falconbridge rose from $\$ 3.25$ to $\$ 3.39$.
