## WETGHTPD JNDEX JTTABERS OT 23 MINING STOCKS <br> $(3.925=100)$

The weighted index number of tiveltymothree mining atocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the baso $9926=100$, was 131.5 for the weak onding May 2nd, as compared with 131.3 for the provious meek.

Nineteen gold stocks fell from 226,4 to 126.2 , and four baso metals stocks rose from 154.7 to 156.4 .

Among the gold stccks maakly avaiage prices behaved as follows:- Bralorne declinod from $\$ 7.77$ to $\$ 7.23$, Granaia from 284 to $26 \phi$, Hollinger from $\$ 17.14$ to $\$ 16.69$, Howoy from 936 to 88 , Lako Shore from $\$ 55.27$ to $\$ 54.87$, Macassa from $\$ 2.33$ to $\$ 2.29$, San Antonio from $\$ 3.61$ to $\$ 3.56$, Sylvanito froin $\$ 2.33$ to $\$ 2.28$, Teck-Hughos from $\$ 4.23$ to $\$ 4.15$ and Wright-Hargreaves from $\$ 9.12$ to $\$ 8.97$. Domo mountod from $\$ 41.81$ to $\$ 42.06$, McIntyre fros $\$ 43.65$ to $\$ 43.87$, Zramior from $\$ 1.70$ to $\$ 1.86$, Pioneer from $\$ 11.39$ to $\$ 11.54$, Reno from $\$ 1.43$ to $\$ 1.51$ and Siscue from $\$ 3.10$ to $\$ 3.12$.

In the bese metals group, Fudicon Pay advanced from $\$ 14.83$ to $\$ 15.09$, Noranda from $\$ 38.57$ to $\$ 38.96$ and Base Metals from $70 \phi$ to $82 \phi$ while Falconbridge fell from $\$ 3.96$ to $\$ 3.87$.
