WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS
(1926=100)

The persistent downward movement of gold was responsible for the decline of the weighted index of 23 mining issues from 118.8 for the week of July 4th to 118.0 for the week ending July 11th. This index compares with 139.8 for the week ending July 12th, 1934.

The weekly average prices were lower for thirteen, unchanged for one and higher for five of the nineteen gold stocks. The index for this group dropped from 112.1 for the week of July 4th to 110.8 for the week ending July 11th. For the corresponding period in 1934, this index was 135.3.

Prices of Hudson Bay and Noranda were higher, causing a gain in the base metals stocks index, which was 150.1 for the week ending July 11th as compared with 149.0 for the preceding week and 163.3 for the week ending July 12th, 1934.

A table of prices as computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics is given below, showing the quotations for the weeks of July 11th, July 4th, 1935, and July 12, 1934.
