WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS (1926-100)

Having moved steadily lower since April 25th, the general index for mining stocks registered 120.3 for the week ending June 27th, as compared with 122.0 for the preceding week and 138.9 for the corresponding week in 1934. This is the lowest index for this year, being the same as that recorded for the final week of January.

Although a few gold issues advanced in price, the downward movement was maintained by the others, placing the index of nineteen gold stocks at 114.3 for the week ending June 27th, as compared with 115.3 for the previous week. For the week ending June 28th, 1934, this index was 134.1.

Mostly due to the influence of Noranda, the index for four base metals stocks for the week ending June 27th declined from 152.1 to 147.9. In 1934, the index for the same week was 163.2.

Following is a comparative table of prices as compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, showing the quotations of the weeks ending June 27th, Jame 20th, 1935, and June 28th, 1934.
