WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS (1926=100)

For eight consecutive weeks, the 23 mining stocks index continuously declined, registering 116.6 for the week ending August 8th, as compared with 117.8 for the preceding week. This index was the lowest reached in 1935. For the same period last year 138.0 was the index recorded.

The gold group index followed a similar movement and dropped from 109.2 for the week of August 1st to 107.8 for the week ending August 8th. For the corresponding week in 1934, this index was 134.7.

Four base metals issues showed practically no change, declining from 154.8 for the week ending August 1, to 154.3 for the week of August 8th. This index compares with 156.8 for the week ending August 9th, 1934.

Following is a table of prices as computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics comparing figures for the week ending August 8th with those of the previous week and also with quotations of August 9th, 1934.
