## HARRHOUSING <br> 1946

Commencing with 1944, an amual report bas been compilod by the Bureau of Statistics on the Warehousing industry and while the coverage of the surey is not yet as complete as desired, the data presently avallable do indicate the general trends in this segment of the service industries.

The current adition includes returns from both members and non-members of the Canadian Warehousemen's Association who were doing a public warehousing business during the year. Cooperatives operating warehouses for their mombers were not included nor were packing houses and other fixms operating storage facilities in connection with their respective businesses. Many werehousing companies also operated a local moving and cartage service and others operated a motor carrier business, including long distance moving. For scme firms the revenue from the carrier business represented a relatively large part of their total revenue and they should be more properly classed as mofor carriers rather than as warehouse companies; however, the following tables show the revenue rrom each activity. The item "Othor Revenues" contains some income from merchandising. As in previous years, returns Srom companies in the Maritime Provinces are grouped because of the amall maber reporting for each province and in order not to reveal individual operations.

There were 14 companfes reporting in 1945 and having a revenue of $\$ 1,004,595$ which failed to report for 1946, while ten companies which did not report in 1915 but were operating, sulwitted schedules for 1946. Their total revenues for the jear amounted to $\$ 648,995$. The number of companies covered by the sumary for 1946 thus shows i decrease of 4 from 1945 and any comparisons between the published reporte are consequentify affected by the non-reporting firms.

A special trible "A" has been prepared for the 127 firme which reported both for 1945 and 1946 and from this a truer evaluation of the trends in the industry is possible. Revenues for this group of 127 repeaters rose from $\$ 14,453,283$ in 1945 to $\$ 14,636,416$ or by 1.2 p, $c$, , while expenses advanced from $\$ 12,590,089$ to $\$ 12,638,052$. Net regrenues consequently improved by $\$ 137,170$ at $\$ 1,998,364$ and net income aftar taxes, etc. was up $\$ 37,476$ at $\$ 1,0 \cap 1,490$ for 1946. Total salaries and mages for these firme were $\$ 6,570,916$ earned by 2,985 regular wage earners, 422 casuals and 970 salaried employees in 1946 compared with $\$ 6,204,948$ aarned by $\$, 226$ wage earners, 754 casuals and 942 aalaried employees for the $\quad$ ame compantes in 1945.

The net occupiable space for household goods reported by 137 companios in 1946 was 1,792, 715 square feet or 33.7 p.c. of the total dry storage space. Cold storage space increased at 14,282,285 cubic feet. Companies are requested to report the percontage of the spase occupied arch month in percentages of the totel. These were converted into space and parcentages computed for the totels. It is evident that approximate figures only were forthcoming in some casas and thus the data should be used with this reservation.

The companies operated 858 twuciss in 1946 , eleven of which were over 6 ton capacity, but of the 103 semitriller unts listed 51 were ovor 6 ton capacity.

Employment recards indicate fairly steady mployment throughout the year brt casual help fuctuated from 351 in February to 641 in Septomber. The considerable amomt of moving on or about May lst and October ist which ma: a feature of pre-war days is now rather ilmitod by the current shortage of accomodation, as well as domestic rental control.

Accidents in which tehicles of the 137 reporting compantes were involved duriag 1946 resulted in injurios to 120 drivers and helperc, 26 to other employees, 5 pedestrians and 2 other persons. As in 1945 there rere no fatalities in the industry during 1346.
