## CURRENT TRENDS IN FOOD DISIRIBUTION <br> November． 1948

This bulletin brings together the information on retail grocery and wholesale grocery and fruit and vegetable sales contained in other monthly bulletins on the retail and wholesale trade。 thus facilitating a comparison of the trends in monthly sales in the two stages of food distri． bution．

WHOLESALE TR／ADE
Grocers＇Sales

Sales of wholesale grocers in November． 1948 were $4 \% 1$ ower in dollar volume than in November， 1947 and $7 \%$ below the October． 1948 rol ume accordinis to statements submitted by 70 of the larger firms across Canada．Cumulative sales for the 11 months of 1948 were $5 \%$ in excess of the volume for the corresponding period of 1947 ．An inciease of $9 \%$ was recorded for British Columbia while wholesalers in all other regions recorded decreases．Sales in the Prairies were down $2 \%$ from November． 1947，in the Maritimes，7\％，in Quebec， $8 \%$ ，and in Ontaric， $9 \%$ ．

Fruit and Vegetable Wholesalers＇Sales
Fruit and vegetable wholesalers＂sales were $2 \%$ below the Novam ber． 1947 level but $13 \%$ higher than the dollar sales in October． 1948 according to reparts from 50 of the la rgar deal ers acrose the country． The cumulative figures for the 11 months of 1948 show a drop of $15 \%$ from the sales volume of the corresponding period of 1947．Fruit and vegete able wholesalers in the Western Provinces reported an increase over November， 1947 of $6 \%$ ，while in Ontario，sales were down $2<$ and in the Maritimes and Quebec combined，there was a drop of $13 \%$ 。

## Grocers Stooks

Inventories of wholesale grocors were valued $21 \%$ higher at November 30,1948 than at the same date in 1947 ，and were $7 \%$ higher than at the beginning of the month．Inventories at the heginning of November are normally $4 s_{\%}^{\circ}$ in excess of the sales volume in that month（based on the average of $1935-1942$ ），while stocks at the begiming of November this year wera il\％higher than the November sales volune．

RETAIL TRADE
Chain Stores - November, 1948 sales of 972 chain store units operated by 27 chain companies in the food retailing field were $12 \%$ hicher than sales of 979 stores operated by 27 firms in November 1947. Average sales per store were $\$ 32,060$ in November, 1948 and $\$ 28,437$ in the same month of the rrevious year.

Sales in the Maritime Provinces were up only $3 \%$ from November, 1947. Other provinces had increases which were consistent with the aver age gain for Canada as a whole.

Comparison of Stores and Sal es for November, 1947 and 1948


Independent Storas - Sales of independent pod stores incrensed $6 \%$ in November, 1048 compared with November, 1347. Quebec, Manitoba and Alberta with sains of $8 \%, 10 \%$ and $13 \%$ respectively, recorded the greatest gains.
