## CURRENT TREINDS IN FOOD DISTRTBUTION, HHY, 1940

## Introduction

Indeves reflecting current trends in food distribution in Canada have been published for some years, indexes of retail and wholesale grocery trading establishments forming components of the two regular monthly bulletins on retail and wholesale trade issued by the Internal Trado Branch of tho Dominion Buroau of Statise tics. This series brings togethor in one roport the information on rotail and wholesalo grocory salos contained in the other bullotins thus facilitating a comparison of the tronds in monthly salos in the two stages of food distribution.

## Wholesalo Trado

Salos of 77 wholosalo houses in tho grocery trado avoragod 25 por cont highor in liay, 1940 than in liay, 1939 and 24 por cont ovor hpril, 1940 , unadjustod induxos, on tho basc 1930 oguals 100, standing at 134.8 for Mey, 1940, 108.8 for kpril, 1940 and 108.1 for ifay, 1939. Tho 25 por cont incranso over biay of tho provious yoar comparod witli a 14 por cont incroaso rocordod in tho ispril corrosponding-nionth comprison and with margins of 1 por cont and 18 por cont rocordod in liarch and Fobrunry ovor tho samo months of 1939. Salos for the yoar to deto avorago 17 por cont abovo tho corrosponding fivo-month poriod of 1939.

iIl soctions of tho country shered in tho incroaso ovor hicy a yorr ngo, rosults for the various oconomic divisions showing incronscs of 23 por cont in tho Maritimo Provincos, 26 por cont in Qucboc, 20 por cont in ontrrio, 29 por cont in tho Prairio Provincos and 28 por cont in British Colurabio.


## Stocks

Inventories carried by the wholesale grocery trade were 38 per cent higher at the end of May than on the corresponding date of 1939 and were 10 per cent higher than at the end of April, 1940. Stocks on hand at any period must be considered in relation to the sales in the immediately followirg period. Stocks on hand at the beginning of liay normally amount to approximately 120 per cent of the kay turnover. The ratio of stocks on hand at the end of April, 1940 formed 117 per cent of Hay sales indicating that in relation to sales realized during the month, stocks on hand were slightly below normal.

## Chain Storos

Sales of 1,104 chain store units operated by 27 chain companies in tho food retailing fiold averagod 26 por cent highor in Nay, 1940, than the salos of 1,281 units oporated by tho same 27 firins in the corrosponding month of 1939. Incroases wore groater in tho Wost than in the East. Chain sales in tho province of Quoboc were up 23 per centf Onteria, 22 per cent; Prairie Provinces, 35 per cont and British Columhia, 48 per cent. Average.daily sales for grocery and meat chains were 24 per cent higher in May, 1940, than in liay, 1939.
