Cor some voar, injexes of retail and wholesale grocery tradinc esthblishmentis forming components of the two rogular montinly bulletins on rotail enc wholos le trede issued by the Internsl Trade Branch of the Doninion Burcau of Statistics. Fhis series brings wofewidu in onc ropont tho infomation on wetuil anc minolesale grovery sales contained in whe other bulletins thus foclitating a comparison of the tronds in wonthly sales in the two stares of food dintribution.

## Wholegale Trade

lovember sales of wholesale crocomy firms increased hy $\overline{3}$ por cont over November, 1947, cocovitine to roportr meanived from 71 of the larcer establishments but declined 14 per cent fron tic dollar volume of business transactod duvim october, $134 \operatorname{con}^{\circ}$ Cumulative figures sor the firot clovon montize of the curxent Jewr stand B per sert highor than for the cormespondine poriod last year. Guocery wholesulers in Ontiario reported a 10 ner cent. inmease in sulos over November last venr while the Maritimes mecorded e gain of 6 ner cent. Sthos in Gueber and the Proivies memaince unchnutcu while British Columbia sules were dovi by 3 per cent.

Inventorios held by wholesale Erucers tet the end of November, 1212, \%ere valued 15 per cant lower than on the corropponding dato of lest year, but increased by $S$ pere cont over the value of stocks reported on hand on October 31,1342 . Stocks on hand at tiae beginning of linvember are nomally 45 ner cent in excess of the amomnt of husinoss transected in that month. Stockes on hence at the bechming of invombor tivis joer wore as ner cont in excose of the volume of businoss francocted, incitcating thet the stoek nositinn nt tho heginnine of Novombor, $194 \%$, was below the normel bosition for thet period of the yoar.
