## FINANCING OF LOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA2 JANUARY, 1938

A drop of 14.0 per cent in number and 4.5 per cent in amount was shown for ínancing of motor vehicle sales in Canada during January compared with January, 1937 . A total of 6,547 new and used motor vehicies were :inanced for $\mathbf{3}, 140,390$ this year and 7,610 at $\$ 3,297,996$ a year ago.

Now vehicles for January totalled 2,246 and the amount $1,727,543$, is contrasted with 2,709 vehicies at $1,365,704$ for January, 1937, a loss of 27.1 per cent in number and 7.4 per cent in amount. Declines were general throughout the Dominion exoepting Alberta, where increases were noted of 25.4 fer cont in number and 41.7 per cent in amount.

Used vehicles amounted to 4,301 , a decline of 12.2 per cent compared with 4,901 for January, 1937. Corresponding amounts, $\$ 1,420,047$ for January this yoar and $\$ 1,432,212$ for the same month a year ago, rogistered a loss for this year of only 0.8 per cent. All western provinces reported increased financing of used vehicles. Gains of 10.8 per cent in number and 23.7 per cent in amount were shown for inenitoba and Sakatchewan. Alberta figures increased 50.3 per cent in number and 54.5 per cent in amount, While in British Columbia used vehicles increased 21.5 per cent in number and 49.3 per cent in amount.

Figures for each month of 1937 have been revised slightly to take account of returns of a small number of contributors whose sshedules were returnad too late for inclusion in the monthly reports.
