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## HONTHLY FIN:NGING OF KOTOR VEHICH ShLES IN CANLDI NOVBMBER, 1939

The volume of financing of ner and used motor vehicles in Canada during November, 1939, amounted to 10,395 units financed for $34,214,35$, reflecting gains of 6 per cent in number and 2 por cont in amount of financing over the 9,804 vehicles financed for $34,118,611$ in the same month of 1938. Is 10 per cent decline below October, 1939, when 11,522 vehicles were financed for $\$ 4,376,340$, was in line with the usual seasonal movemont. During the first eleven months of the current year, there was a decline of 8 per cont in number and 12 per cent in amount of finoncing below the corresponding period last year, 141,753 units financed for $557,812,869$ to the end of November, 1939, comparing with 153,793 transnetions involving $365,724,264$ in the seme period of 1938.

New vehiclo finencing declined only 4 per cent in number and 3 per cout in amount, the most favourable year-to-year comparison recorded during any month of 1939. There were 2,568 vehicles financed for $\$ 1 ; 879,028$ in November, 1939, and 2,674 vehicles finenced for $31,940,071$ in November, 2938. Wide variations were disclosed in the comparisons of regional totrls for November, 2939, end November last year. Financing of nev vehioles in Manitobe and Saskatchowan combined increased 54 per cent, while a smaller increase of 8 per cent was reported for the Maritime Provinces. Declines occurred in all other sections of the country as follows: klbertc, 1 per cent; Quebec, 9 per cent; Britisk Codumbia, 9 per cent and ontario, 18 per cont.

Increases recorded in all regions of the country for used vehicle financing resulted in advances of 10 por cent in number and 7 per cent in amount of financing over Novamber last year for the Dominion as a whole. Wost pronounced gains in this field also were registered in Manitoba and Saskatchewen combined and in the Nicritime Provinces, where increases vere 42 per cent and 24 per cent respectively over corresponding figures for November, 1938. Gains recorded in other sections were as follows: 8 per cont in Alberta, 6 per cent in Quebec, 3 por cent in Ontario, and 1 per cent in British Columbia:
