
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MONTHLY FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, MARCH, 1939


There was a continued decline in financing of new and used motor vehicles during the month of March, 1939, the 10,344 units financed for \$4,278,468 being 18 per cent in number and 20 per cent in amount below the 12,575 vehicles financed for \$5,341,318 in the same month last year. An advance of 54 per cent over February, 1939, reflects the commencement of the usually heavy spring business. During the first quarter of the current year, 23,440 vehicles have been financed to the extent of \$9,853,364, 15 per cent in number and 19 per cent in amount below the 27,416 units financed for \$12,105,990 in the corresponding period of 1938.


Declines of 27 per cent in number and 26 per cent in amount occurred in new motor vehicle financing during March. New vehicles financed in March, 1939, numbered 2,591 with a financed value of \$\overline{2}\$1,916,727, compared with 3,568 vehicles which were financed for \$\overline{2}\$2,594,953 in March, 1938. Declines of varying significance occurred in all sections of the country. Alberta recorded a decrease of 2 per cent; the Maritime Provinces, 13 per cent; British Columbia, 24 per cent; Ontario, 27 per cent; Quebec, 38 per cent; and Manitoba and Saskatchewan combined, 42 per cent.

Used vehicle financing declined 14 per cent in both number and volume, 7,753 units being financed for \$2,361,741 in March, 1939, while 9,007 vehicles were financed for \$2,746,365 in the same month last year. British Columbia and the Maritime Provinces recorded the only increases, 14 per cent and 1 per cent respectively over March, 1938.

Declines in the other regions were as follows: Alberta, 4 per cent; Manitoba and Saskatchewan, 15 per cent; Ontario, 20 per cent; and Quebec, 25 per cent.

NUMBER OF MOTOR VEHICLES FINANCED IN CANADA: 1933-1939




