## MONTHLY FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANFADA, SEPTEMBER, 1339

The effect of the overseas conflict on the automobile financing business was reflected in results for the month of September, when the number of new and used vehicles financed declined 15 per cent below September, 1938, while the corresponding decline in amount of financing was 16 per cent. The improvement in the trend of motor vehicle financing which was evidenced in results for the four previous morths was thus brought to a halt. Volume of financing in September, 1939, totalled 10, 128 units with a financed value of $\{4,100,668$, compared with 11,863 vehicles financed for $\$ 4,889,261$ in the same month last year. During the first nine months of the current year, 119,836 vehicles have been financed for an amount of $449,222,174,10$ per cent in number and 14 per cent in amount below the 132,596 units financed for $57,020,710$ in the corresponding period of 1938.

New vehicle financing declined 19 per cent in number and 20 per cent in amount of financing with 2,404 transactions involving $\$ 1,791,655$ in September, 1939, against 2,978 contracts involving $\$ 2,228,910$ in September, 1938. Declines were only 4 and 7 per cent respectively for lanitoba and Saskatchowan combinod and for the province of Queboc, but more pronounced decreases occurred in other regions. The citcrease in Ontario was 24 per cent; in the Maritime Provinces, 26 per cent; in Alberta, 27 per cont, and in British Columbia, 39 per cent.

A total of 7,724 used vehicles were financed for $4,2,309,013$ during September, 1939, while 8,885 vehicles were financed for $2,660,351$ in September, 1938. Declines were 13 per cent both in number and amount of financing. Alberta recorded the only advance over September, 1938, with a gain of 2 per cent. Decreases occurred in all othor sections, as follows: the Karitime Provinces, 2 per cent; Quebec, 5 per cent; Manitoba and Saskatchowan, 9 per cent; Ontario, 18 per cent, and British Columbia, 30 per cont.
