


MONTHLY FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, APRIL, 1940

There were 19,902 new and used motor vehicles financed for \$8,663,644 in ipril, 1940, up 23 per cent in number and 25 per cent in amount of financing from the 16,223 units financed for \$6,913,295 in the same month last year. A normal seasonal advance was recorded over March, when 12,692 vehicles were financed for \$5,468,912, while the improvement over April, 1939, was only slightly lower than the average for the first three months of the current year over the corresponding period a year ago. Financing of motor vehicles during the first four months of 1940 totalled 50,032 units with a financed value of 221,882,654, 25 per cent in number and 29 per cent in amount of financing above the 40,131 vehicles financed to the extent of \$15,993,671 in the corresponding period of 1939.

Increases in new vehicle financing during .pril were somewhat smaller than those recorded in earlier months of 1940 over corresponding months of last year. The 5,783 vehicles financed for 34,311,096 in the most recent month were, however, up 23 per cent in number and 28 per cent in financed value over the 4,688 units financed for 3,372,364 in april, 1939. The largest gains recorded in this field were those of Lanitoba and Saskatchevan combined, where an increase of 50 per cent was recorded, and of the Maritime Provinces, where new vehicle financing was up 48 per cent over april a year ago. There were gains of 30 per cent in Ontario, 19 per cent in Quebec and 10 per cent in British Columbia, but ilberta showed a drop of 27 per cent below ipril, 1939.

The improved trend in used vehicle financing was well maintained, the 14,119 vehicles financed for 24,352,548 in April, 1940, being 22 per cent in number and 23 per cent in amount of financing above the 11,535 vehicles which were financed for 3,540,931 in april, 1939. The Maritime Provinces recorded the greatest gain in used vehicle financing with improvement of 52 per cent over April last year. Other regions showing increases over april, 1939, were as follows: Quebec, 35 per cent; Ontario, 28 per cent; Manitoba and Saskatchewan combined, 22 per cent, and British Columbia, 15 per cent. .lberta recorded the only decline in used vehicle financing also, the total for .pril, 1940, for that province being 28 per cent below that recorded in april a year ago.




