
MONTHLY FINANCING OF MCTOR WEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, JUNE, 1940


The volume of financing of new and used motor vehicle sales in Canada 1940, totalled 21,169 vehicles financed for \$8,878,215, 13 per cent in number and 18 per cent in amount of financing above the 18,715 units financed for \$7,506,101 in Juhe, 1939. The decline below May, the peak month for motor vehicle financing, was in line with the usual seasonal movement. During the first half of the current year, there were 95,542 vehicles financed to the extent of \$41,260,600, gains over the 80,773 vehicles financed for \$33,848,144 in the corresponding period of 1939 amounting to 18 per cent in number and 22 per cent in amount of financing.

Percentage gains over June, 1939, were considerably greater for new vehicles than for used vehicles financed. The 5,330 new vehicles financed for \$4,018,905 in June of this year were higher by 27 per cent in number and 24 per cent in amount of financing than the 4,209 units financed for 93,246,659 in June a year ago, Improvement over June, 1939, was greater in the Prairie Provinces than in other regions of the country. Combined figures for Manitoba and Saskatchewan were up 76 per cent over June last year, while a gain of 30 per cent occurred in Alberta. Increases were recorded in all other regions, as follows: 24 per cent in Ontario, 21 per cent in the Maritime Provinces, 18 per cent in British Columbia and 1 per cent in Quobeco

The 15,839 used vehicles which were financed for \$4,859,310 in Canada in June, 1940, were up 9 per cent in number and 14 per cent in amount of financing over the 14,506 vehicles financed for \$4,259,442 in June a year ago. Most pronounced gains in this field also occurred in the Prairie Provinces. In Alberta, the advance amounted to 28 per cent and in Manitoba and Saskatchewan, 22 per cent. Ontario figures were up 11 per cent, the Maritime Provinces increased 10 per cent, while a lesser gain of 4 per cont was reported for British Columbia. Quebec was the only province which recorded a doclino, usod vehiclo financing falling off 10 per cent in that province compared with June, 1939.

Number of Motor Vehicles Financed in Canada, 1933-1940


