## MONTHLY FTNANCING OF MOTOR VEHICIE S.IES IN GNNDH, JULY, 2940

Sales of 17,455 new and used motor vehicles were financed in Canada during July for an amount of $\$ 6,752,825$, 11 per cent higher in both number and amount of financing than the 15,801 vehicles financed for $\$ 6,108,704$ in July a yoar ago. inlthough somewhat lower than the average increase for the first half of this year over last, the gain over July, 1939, is only slightly lower then advances reported during the two proceding months. Declines in new vehicle financing, resulting from diminishod s?los duo to recent tax increases, were of fset by improvement in the used vohicle field.

Cunulative totals for the first seven months of this year showed 112,997 now end used vehicles financed for $348,012,425,17$ per cont in number and 20 por cent in amount of finencing above the 96,574 units financed to the extent of $339,956,848$ in the same poriod of 1939.

Now vehiclo financing doclinod 9 por cont in numbor and 5 por cent in amount, 2,848 venicles being finenced for $32,290,959$ in July, 1940, compared with 3,145 units fincncod for $2,405,739$ in the same month lest yerr. ill economic divisions recorded declinos below July, 1939, with the oxcoption of Menitoba end Sr.skr.tchowen, whore now vehiclo finencing incroasod 9 por cent. British Columbis and ilbertr, with docroc.sos of 23 and 18 por cont respoctively, suffored the most severo losses. Declines of 13 per cont woro roportod for both Ontario and Quoboc, whilo s drop of 2 por cont occurrod in tho Miaritimo Provincos.

There wore 14,607 usod vohicles finencod for $34,460,866$ in July of this yoer, up 15 por cent in number and 21 per cont in amount of finencing ovor tho 12,656 vohiclos financod for $33,702,965$ in July, 1939. Incrensos woro rocordod in all rogions of tho country, with Ontario's 21 por cont ravance lording r.ll othors. Improvement of 16 por cont in tho combinod totrls for Menitoba and Saskntcbewen wns similer to the grin shown for islbortc. British Columbis and tho Meritimo Provincos recorded idonticel geins of 13 por cont, whilo usod vehiclo finencing in Quoboc wns 3 por cont highor.
