## MONTHEY FINANCING OF HOTOR DBTCTI SATSS IN GHND

Wotor ventele ifazciag in Ganada continues higher than in corresponding months of earlíer yoars, gains ia January, 1941, standing at 16 per cent in number and 25 por cent in amount of financing over januarys 2940. Thara woro 9,325 now and used vohicles financod in januery, 1942 , for 36545.020 , compared with 8,059 units financed for $\$ 3,628,207$ in tino corrusponding month a year ago

Incrorses in new valicio financing ware loss pronouncod than those recorded in tho used voniclo filla novaitholoss gains of 3 por cont in numbor and 17 por cont in valuo woro roportod for January this yoat ovor list. Thoro woro 2,528 now vohiclos financod for $\$ 2,237,369$ in January of tinis yoar, comparod with 2,45 vohiclos financee for $\$ 1,834,988$ in January a year ago. Substantial gains occuried in all regions of the country excepting the Prairie Provinces. An increase of 27 per cent in British Columbia was the largest recorded and was followed by improvement: of 23 per cent in tho Maritime Provinces. Quebec and Ontario zepozted gains of $16^{\prime}$ and 12 per cont rospoctively. New vohicle financing in Alberta decined 15 per cent and in Nanitoba and Jaskatchuran combined, 25 per cent.

Increases in financing of usod vehicles for Canade as a wholg amounted to 21 per cent in numbur and 34 per cens in financod value, 6,797 voliclos boing financed for ${ }^{2}, 407,151$ in January: 1941: as against 5,615 units financed for $\$ 1,793,219$ in the same month of 2940. The increas in Ontario far surpassod that rocorded in other soctions of tho country, financing of usod rohiclos in that provinco gaining 32 por cont. Gains rocordod in othor rugions of tho country furo as follows: 19 pur cont in tho Maritimo Provincos, 14 por cont in British Columsia, 10 por cunt in boђin Quojuc and ílborta. Combinod figuros for Manitobe, and Seskatchowan wor down 5 por cont from last yoar.

Sinco publication of the Docombor issuc of this bullotin, adjustmonts have boon mado to tho 1940 totais, and tho figurus for that your containod in this bullotin may bo rogardod as final.
