## NONTHLY FINANCING OF HOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANHDhe JULY, 1941

July financing of motor vehicle sales in Canada resumed the series of increases in corresponding-month comparisons with last year which characterised results for all months of 1941 with the exception of the immediately preceding month of June, when volume foll slightly below the June, 1940 ¥otal. The number of new and used vehicles financed in July of this year totalled 29,518 having a financed value of $\mathbf{~} 9,104,630$, up 12 per cent in number and 35 per cent in dollar volume over the 17,506 units financed for $\$ 6,764,906$ in the same month of 1940. During the first seven months of the current year, there havo beon 127,093 transactions involving an amount of $\psi 60,452,679$, as compared with 112,941 contracts totalling $847,779,611$ in the corrasponding period of 1940 .

Financing of new vohicle sales, aftor showing declines of 7 and 18 per cent in May and June rospoctivoly bolow corresponding months a yoar ago, ro-actod sharply in July with gains of 42 por cont in numbor and 52 por cont in dollar volumo. Thoro woro 4,045 now vohiclos financod for $33,497,057$ in July, 1941, whilo 2,845 units ware financod for $2,301,572$ in July of last yoar. Substantial incroasos were rocordod in all rogions of tho country. A gain of 65 por cont in British Columbia was followod by incroasos of 57 por cont in Ontario and 55 por cont in \&uoboc. Tho Maritimo Provincos roported a gain of 35 por cont, siborta rose 24 por cent, Whilo lianitoba and Saskatchowan figuras waro up 13 por cont ovor July, 1940.

In the usod vohiclo ficld, rosults wore moro in lino with thoso shown for tho imnodiately procoding months of liay and Juno, gains of 6 por cont in numbor and 26 per cent in valuo being recordod over July, 1940 figuros. The 15,473 usod vehiclos financod for $35,607,573$ compare with 14,661 units financod to the extont of $4,463,334$ in July, 1940. Tho Miaritimo Provincos and filborte showed doclinos of 3 and 4 par cont respectivoly, but all othor rogions roportod gains ovor July a yoar ago. British Columbia's increase of 19 por cont wes riore pronouncod then thoso rocordod for othor soctions of the country which wore as follows: 8 por cont for Manitobe and Seskatchowan combinad, 6 por cont for Onterio and 4 por cont for Quebec.
