## NONTHLY FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANAD, SEPTELBER, 1942

Financing of motor vehicle sales during September totalled 5,332 units financed for an anount of $\$ 1,761,805$, down 60 per cent in number and 71 per cent in dollar volume from the 13,247 new and used vehicles financed to the extent of $\$ 5,985,292$ in September of last year. Cumulative totals for the first nine months showed 55,547 vehicles financed for $\$ 21,075,461$, as compared with 157,046 vehicles financed for $\$ 73,769,665$ in the corresponding period of 1941 , declines amounting to 65 per cent in number and 71 per cent in amount of financing.

There were 229 now vehicles financed for an amount of $\$ 182,139$ in September, 1942, less than 10 per cent of the volume for September a year ago when 2,519 new vehicles were financed for $\$ 2,162,165$. In both number and volume new vehicle financing during the first nine months of this year was only 20 per cent of the amount recorded in the seme period of last year. Declines below September, 1941, were greater then 80 per cent in ell regions of the country and ranged as high as 97 per cent for Manitoba and Saskatchewan togethere

In the used vehicle field, declines below September, 1941, amounted to 52 per cent in number and 59 per cont in amount of financing, the 5,103 vehicles financed for $\$ 1,579,666$ in the month under review comparing with 10,728 units financed for a total amount of $\$ 3,823,127$ in September last year. Totals for the first nine months revealed decreases of 60 per cent in number and 65 per cent in amount below the similar period of 1941. The decline in number in the Maritime Provinces was 71 per cent below September, 1941s while decreases recorded for other regions ranged from 47 to 58 per cent.
