## MONTALY PINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, MOVEMBER, 1943

New and used motor vehicles financed in Canada during November totalled 2,739 units with a financed value of \$1,176,269, 22 per cent lower in number but 5 per cent higher in dollar volume than the 3,487 vehicles financed for \$1,116,749 in November, 1942. There were 155 new vehicles financed in November, 1943 for an amount of \$205,437.

In the used vahicle field, declines were 2% per cent in number and 8 per cent in amount of financing, the 2,584 vehicles financed for \$972,832 in the month under review comparing with 3,401 transactions involving \$1,055,046 in the same month last year. Decreases in the numbers of used vehicles financed in various regions of the country were as follows: 48 per cent in the Maritime Provinces, 17 per cent in Quebec, 23 per cent in Ontario, 47 per cent in Manitoba and Saskatchewan combined, 4 per cent in Alberta and 8 per cent in British Columbia.

cumulative results for the first eleven months showed 938 new motor vehicles financed this year as compared with 7,348 new vehicles financed in the corresponding period of 1942. Used vehicles financed in the period from January to Novemher, 1943 numbered 36,186 units and 56,429 units in the similar period of last year.
