MONTHLY FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1943

New and used motor vehicles financed in Canada during February, 1943, totalled 1,935 units with a financed value of \$672,762 down 61 per cent in number and 69 per cent in amount of financing below the 4,931 vehicles financed to the extent of \$2,162,859 in February, 1942. There were only 49 new vehicles included in this total and their financing involved \$40,215.

Financing of sales of used motor vehicles declined 52 per cent in both number and dollar volume, the 1,886 units financed for \$632,547 in the month under review comparing with 3,959 vehicles financed for \$1,306,529 in February a year ago. Regional results show the following declines: British Columbia, 31 per cent; Ontario, 48 per cent; Alberta, 51 per cent; Quebec 63 per cent; Maritime Provinces, 68 per cent and Manitoba and Saskatchewan (combined), 75 per cent.
