MONTHLY FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SAIES IN CANADA, OCTOBER, 1944

New and used motor vehicles financed by finance companies in Canada during October, 1944 totalled 2,354 units with a financed value of \$1,076,237, down 23 per cent in number and 15 per cent in amount of financing from the 3,045 vehicles financed in October last year for \$1,262,897. Included in the October, 1944 totals were 213 new vehicles financed to the extent of \$284,077.

Financing of used vehicles declined 26 per cent both in number and in dollar volume, 2,141 units being financed for \$792,160 in the month under review compared with 2,886 transactions involving \$1,074,701 in the same month last year. Declines below October last year were less extensive in Quebec and Ontario than in other sections of the country. The number of used vehicles financed in Quebec during October this year fell off only 2 per cent from last year's figure, while Ontario recorded a 14 per cent decrease in the same comparison. The following reductions were reported for other regions: 36 per cent in British Columbia, 48 per cent in Alberta, 50 per cent in the Maritime Provinces and 56 per cent in combined figures for Manitoba and Saskatchewan.

There were 1,955 new vehicles financed in the first ten months of 1944 compared with 787 new vehicles financed in the same period of last year. Used vehicles financed in the January-to-October period numbered 27,179 this year and 33,680 in 1943.
