The financing of sales of new and used motor vehicles in Canada during February, 1945 totalled 1,742 units with a financed value of \$eoe, 794, down 24 fer cent in number and 15 jer cent in amount of finance in e from the 2,306 voliicles financed in February last year for $\$ 353,930$. Included in the February, 1945 totals were 183 now vehicles financed to the extent of $223,058$.

Used vehicle financing; declined 29 per cent in number and 27 per cent in dollar volume, 1,553 units being financed for $\$ 85,730$ in the month under review as compared with $2,1 \varepsilon 3$ transactions involving $\$ 800,816$ in the sane month a year ago. quebec recorded a slight increase in used velicle financing, but declines continued in otice sections of the country. Iercentage decreases by regions were as follows: Britis! Columbia, 18; Ontario, 32; Maritime Provinces, 35; Alberta, 40 and lanitoku and jaskatciewan combined,44.

There were 373 new vehicles financed in the first two months of 1945 compared with $2 \epsilon^{\prime}$ new vehicles financed in the correspondice period a your ago. Used vehicles finance banc the same two months totalled 2,800 in 1345 and 4,132 in 1344.
