## MONTHLY FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, JANUARY, 1946

The volume of motor vehicle financing in Canada in January involved 2,311 transactions for a total value of \$1,322,522, higher by 54 per cent in both number and dollar amount than the 1,504 contracts negotiated in January, 1945 for an amount of \$856,898. There were 456 new vehicles financed in the month under review while only 191 new units were financed in January a year ago.

Increases in used vehicle financing amounted to 41 per cent in number and 18 per cent in dollar volume over January of last year. Considerably more than half of the transactions were concentrated in Ontario where an 82 per cent increase over January, 1945 was recorded. Substantial gains occurred also in the Maritime Provinces and in Alberta, while a minor increase was reported for British Columbia. Results for Manitoba and Saskatchewan combined and for Quebec showed declines of 9 and 4 per cent respectively. These were in striking contrast with increases for adjacent regions.

A new series is introduced in this issue which gives details for passenger and commercial models separately. This development has been possible through the co-operation of Canadian finance companies reporting monthly to the Bureau of Statistics. January, 1946 results appear in Table 2 of this report. Comparative data for January, 1945 are not available. The summary for the month under review reveals the extent to which activity in the new vehicle field is concentrated on the financing of commercial vehicles, while at the same time transactions involving passenger models predominate in the used vehicle field. Of the 456 new vehicles financed, 372 were trucks and buses, while the used vehicle total of 1,855 included 1,361 passenger cars.

Tables 3 and 4 contain summaries of the final tabulations of the monthly and regional totals for the year 1945. There were 3,630 new vehicles financed last year and, although more than 50 per cent greater than the 1944 total, volume continued far below normal as passenger car output for civilian consumption had not yet reached significant proportions. Used vehicles financed in 1945 numbered 24,356, falling 20 per cent below 1944 volume. Declines in used vehicle financing were particularly substantial in the early part of the year. During the later months, however, there was a gradual narrowing of the margin between the two years and the last quarter totals show volume higher in 1945 than in the corresponding period of 1944.
