MONTHLY FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, JUNE, 1946

Finance companies in Canada contracted to finance the purchase of 4,452 motor vehicles, including both new and used models, in June, 1946 for a total amount of $\$ 5,586,736$. These figures represent increases of 53.6 per cent in number of units and 143.2 per cent in dollar volume compared with June of last year when a total of 2,885 new and used models were financed for $\$ 1,475,273$.

Included in the totals for June, 1946 were 2,208 now vehicles which were financed for $\$ 2,630,489$ and 2,224 used vehicles which were financed for $\$ 956,247$. The level of new vehicle financing in June was practically on a par with that of the two preceding months, the 2,208 vehicles reported for June comparing with 2,333 vehicles for May and 2,295 for April. Cumulative totals for the first half of 1946 show 9,388 new vehicles financed for $\$ 10,940,539$ compared with 1,679 new vehicles financed for $\$ 2,301,169$ in the corresponding period of 1945.

The 2,208 new vehicles financed in June included 1,154 passenger models and 1,054 models of a commercial type. During the first six months of 1946 there were 4,408 new passenger cars financed for $\$ 4,013,329$ and 4,980 new commercial models financed for $\$ 6,927,210$.

In the used vehicle field the 2,224 vehicles financed for $\$ 956,247$ in June, 1946 represents a reduction from the preceding month of May when 2,825 used units were financed for $\$ 1,284,436$. Cumulative totals for the first half of the current year show 15,306 used vehicles financed for $\$ 6,431,591$.

The 2,22.4 used vehicles financed in june included l,652 passenger cars and 572 commercial vehicles. Total figures for the first six months of 1946 show that there were 11,565 used passenger cars financed for $\$ 3,696,538$ and 3,741 used commercial vehicles financed for $\$ 2,735,053$.
