FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALESDECEMBER, 1947

Motor vehicle sales financed by Canadian finance companies in December numbered 9,195 units having a financed value of \$9,878,507. Included in these figures were 3,954 new vehicles financed for \$6,591,406. Increases over December, 1946 were substantial for both classes, amounting to 61% for new vehicles and 122% for used vehicles.

New Vehicles:--New passenger car financing remained almost on a par with volume in earlier months of the year, 2,640 cars being financed for \$4,209,133 in December. Financing of new commercial models, on the other hand, was reduced in comparison with volume for most other months of 1947. Increases over December, 1946 amounted to 97% for new passenger cars and 17% for new trucks and buses.

Used Vehicles:--A total of 5,241 units were financed in the used vehicle field. Used passenger models numbered 3,955 and commercial vehicles totaled 1,246. These totals represented gains of 147% and 68% respectively.

Preliminary Annual Results

There were 117,447 new and used motor vehicles financed during the year 1947 for \$108,767,046, more than double the 53,393 units financed to the extent of \$41,586,565 in 1946. The totals quoted for 1947 are subject to revision.

Greatest expansion occurred in new passenger car financing last year, the increase amounting to 146% over the number financed in 1946. A total of 46,547 new vehicles were financed. The total amount of financing involved was \$66,005,941.

The total of used vehicles financed in the full year was 70,900 and their financed value was \$42,761,105. A large part of the total, 55,064 units, were used passenger cars.
