MONTHLY FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1947

Financing of both new and used motor vehicle sales was considerably higher in February this year than last. There was also a marked upward movement between January and February of this year.

New vehicles financed in February numbered 2,764 and the amount of financing involved was \$3,711,879. Transactions were more than three times as numerous as in February a year ago when 891 units were financed for \$1,072,902. Although outnumbered by new passenger cars, commercial vehicles formed a sizable portion of the total financing transactions in the new vehicle field. The number of new passenger cars financed was 1,621, while the total of commercial vehicles was 1,143.

Increases in used vehicle financing over February, 1946, were fairly uniform for both passenger and commercial models, amounting to 39 and 42 per cent respectively. There were 2,343 used passenger cars financed in February, 1947 to the extent of \$1,023,868, while 770 used trucks and buses were financed for \$637,326.
