## STATISTICS OF AUTOMOBILE FINANCING

The figures for automobile financing compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics show a drop in October as compared with September of this year, and also indicate a falling off in financing as compared with the corresponding month (October) in 1929. The per cent of change is -45.0.

The total number of cars financed was 7,987 in October 1930, 8,141 in September 1930 and 12,380 in October 1929, and the amount of financing was \$24,506 in October 1930, \$4,199,355 in September 1930, and \$6,841,174 in October 1929.

**S** New cars financed were 2,491 in October 1930, 3,100 in September 1930 and 4,925 in October 1929, while used cars financed were 5,696 in September 1930, 5,041 in September 1930 and 7,455 in October 1929.

Values of new cars financed were \$1,266,065 in October 1930, \$1,733,884 in September 1930 and \$3,869,531 in October 1929. Values in used cars financed were \$2,475,741 in October 1930, \$2,465,471 in September 1930 and \$2,971,643 in October 1929.
