

CThe figures for automobile financing compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics show a drop in September as compared with August of this

 was $\$ 4,199,355$ in September 1930, $\$ 4,904,574$ in August 1930, and $\$ 6,670,852$ in September 1929 .

Netw cars financed were 3,100 in September 1930, 3,621 in August 1930 and 4,910 in September 1929 , while used cars financed were 5,041 in August 1930, 6, 256 in August 1930 and 6,875 in September 1929.

Values of new cars financed were $1,733,884$ in September $1930, \$ 1,993,781$ in August 1930 and $4,015,463$ in September 1929 . Values in used cars financed were $\$ 2,465,471$ in September 1930, $2,910,793$ in August 1930 and $\$ 2,655,389$ in Septermber 1929 .
