FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES

MAY, 1948

Financing of motor vehicle sales in May totalled 15,543 units with a financed value of \$14,282,526. There were 4,567 new vehicles financed, while the number of used vehicles totalled 10,976. Increases over May, 1947 amounted to 11% for new and 47% for used vehicles. There was a slight reduction in May compared with April of this year.

New Vehicles

Passenger car financing was down 8% while commercial vehicles recorded an increase of 33%. There were 2,011 passenger models financed in May this year compared with 2,183 in May, 1947. The number of commercial vehicles was 2,556 units in May, 1948 and 1,917 last year.

Used Vehicles

In the used vehicle field the May increase for passenger cars was 55%, while for trucks and buses the gain was 24% compared with the same month of 1947.
