### FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES

APRIL, 1949

A total of 24,474 vehicles were financed in April, 1949 for \$23,346,591, higher by 50% in number and 56% in amount of financing than the 16,295 units financed for \$14,929,095 in April, 1948.

#### New Vehicles --

New passenger vehicles which formed the bulk of the new vehicles totalled 5,508 units in April this year, more than double the 1948 figure. On the other hand, the increases recorded in the new commercial vehicle field were fairly moderate. New passenger cars, trucks and buses combined totalled 8,511 units and were financed for \$12,000,489. This figure surpassed the previous year's totals, for the month under review, by 62% in number and 61% in amount.

#### Used Vehicles --

April, 1949 showed a total of 15,963 used vehicles financed for \$11,346,102 and constituted an increase of 45% in number and 52% in financed value compared with the 11,043 vehicles which were financed for \$7,487,251 in April, 1948. Included in these totals were 13,203 used passenger cars which accounted for \$9,068,605 in financing.
