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## MONTHIY INLEXES OF COUNTRY GIMFTAL STORE SIIES, FERRUARY, 1946

F'ebruary sales of country eeneral stores were practically unchanee from Jenuary and were 10 yer cent higher than in February a year ago. The murein of increase over February last year was about on a par with that recorded in the correspondine January comparison, cumulative sales for the first two months of 1946 standing 9.3 per cent above the similar two-month period a year ago. Unadjusted indexes of sules on the base, 1955-1939 = 100 stood at 139.8 for February, 138.1 for January and at 127.3 for February, 1945.

In continuation of the marked increase recoraed in British Columbit in January, February sules in this province eained d's per cent over February of last year. Much more moderate gains were recoraed in all other regions, parecntage changes in sales in Fehruary of this year compered with last standike at 10 per cent for Alberta, 11 per cent for Saskutchewan, 6 per cent for Manitoba, 8 per cent for ontario, 8 per cent for quebec and 9 per cent for the liaritime Provinces.

The index of sales, adjustea for differences in number of business arys and for normal seasonal movenents, advanced from 180 C in January to 187.8 in February.

These results are based on jeturns receivec from a sample group of 718 stores, carryine a general line of merchandise and located in places of 2,000 population or less.
