MONTHLY INDEXES OF COUNTRY GENERAL STORE SALES, SEPTEMBER, 1946 (1935-1939=100)

Country general store sales in Canada increased 8 per cent in September of this year over last, but the dollar volume of business was reduced by 14 per cent from the preceding month of August, 1946. Although the increase in September was on a much reduced scale compared with gains recorded in most of the earlier months of the year, this is partially accounted for by the fact that there were only four Saturdays in September this year and five Saturdays in September, 1945. When results are adjusted to an average daily sales basis, the September increase becomes 10 per cent, a gain which is almost on a par with the average increase of 12 per cent for the first nine months of the year over the similar period of 1945. Unadjusted index of sales for September was 188.7 (on the base 1935-1939 = 100), as compared with 175.4 for September, 1945 and 219.6 for August, 1946. These results were obtained from reports provided by 716 general stores distributed throughout all sections of the country and located in small towns and rural areas.

The experience of country general stores in different sections of the country varied considerably. Manitoba, British Columbia and Saskatchewan stores reported gains of 16, 13 and 12 per cent respectively over September, 1945. The other western province, Alberta, had the lowest among the provincial increases when sales showed only a minor gain of 3 per cent. Gains in eastern areas were more moderate and amounted to 8 per cent in the Maritime Provinces, 6 per cent in Quebec and 4 per cent in Ontario.
