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## MONTHLY INDEXES OF COUNTRX GENERAL STORE SALES Aprile 19/4/4

Country general store sales everaged 11 per cent higher in April this year than last according to reports received from 579 of these generol merchandise stores located in the smeller towns and rurel areas. The 11 per cent gein reflects on increase in trading activities in all regions of the country, gains ranging from 1 per cent in the northern part of Ontario to 17 per cent in the southern section of Alberta. Sales increased by 2 per cent in British Columbia, 5 por cent in Manitoba, 6 per cent in Onterio, 9 per cent in Quebec, 1/4 per cent in Saskatchewan, 15 per cent in Alberto, and 16 per cent in the Meritime Provinces.

Allowing for the difference in number and sales importunce of the business days of April this year and last and elso for normel seasonal movemente, sales in April mere 17 per cent over April a year ago and increased by 10 per cent over March, 1944. There were five Saturdays in April of the current year as compared with four Saturdays in April, 1943, but there was one nore businese day in April of last year than this.
